

SUBJECT: CLOSING OF SCHOOLS

The schools may be closed because of inclement weather, contagious disease, or other emergencies. The District Superintendent or his/her designee(s) is authorized to make this decision for the health, welfare, and safety of pupils and employees. Whenever possible, ample notice will be given parents, students, and employees through the use of radio and television stations and other appropriate procedures. The District Superintendent is also empowered to close District offices and other non-pupil-related services when in his/her sole discretion conditions warrant the closing.

The District Superintendent shall develop administrative regulations in consultation with component school districts to implement this policy.
