

SUBJECT: SAFETY/SECURITY

It is the policy of BOCES to provide a safe and secure environment to all those persons (students, staff and visitors) who lawfully enter upon BOCES property, vehicles or occupied leased facilities.

It shall be the responsibility of the District Superintendent to establish and carry out written regulations, which will:

- a. Identify those staff members who will be responsible for the effective administration of the regulations, required safety drills and inspections and training.
- b. Establish a District-wide Safety Committee and Building-level Safety Teams.
- c. Provide staff time and other necessary resources for the effective administration of the regulations.
- d. Establish periodic (at least annually) written review of the activities of the staff to ensure compliance with applicable laws and regulations.
- e. Provide an on-going mechanism for the effective review of safety and security concerns of staff, students and affected public.
- f. Provide for periodic reports to the Board (at least annually) regarding the significant aspects of safety and security of the BOCES pursuant to SAVE regulations.

The District-wide School Safety Plan will be filed with the Commissioner of Education.
