

**SUBJECT: HAZARD COMMUNICATION STANDARD**

The Board recognizes the rights of all personnel to work in a healthy and safe environment, which is as free as practicable from recognized hazards and risks to their safety. Therefore, all personnel shall be provided with applicable training to comply with the New York State "Right-to-Know" Law and the Hazard Communication Standard.

The Board directs the District Superintendent to adopt rules and regulations to ensure implementation of this policy, which shall include awareness information, employee training and record keeping.
