

SUBJECT: ADULT EDUCATION

The BOCES recognizes the value of education to people of all ages. As such, the Board encourages the District Superintendent to establish fiscally sound procedures to foster the enrollment of "adult" students in any appropriate existing program and to establish programs, where feasible, to serve this population when such service will not detract from our responsibilities to the school age residents of component school districts.

Tuition rates for Adult Education programs will be set by the District Superintendent or designee.

The pay rate for employees in BOCES operated adult programs will be established annually by the Board.

Adult Education - Senior Citizens

All senior citizens 60 years of age or over and who reside in any of the WSWHE BOCES component school districts may be permitted to enroll in the Adult Education course with a 10% discount off the cost of each course.
