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Articulation Agreement


SUNY Adirondack and WSWHE BOCES

In recognition of the efforts and accomplishments of students who successfully complete the program in Machine Tool Technology Studies at the Washington-Saratoga-Warren-Hamilton-Essex Board of Cooperative Education Services, SUNY Adirondack will award three credits for TEC190 "Cam Programming" provided the conditions listed below are met.


1. If the WSWHE BOCES student successfully passes the Machine Tool Technology program with a "C" or better, three credits will be awarded for TEC190, Cam Programming.
2. Student will pass the NOCTI-Precision Machining as their Technical Assessment and will need to pass BOTH the written and performance portion of the exam.
3. The student will have graduated from high school.
4. The student becomes a matriculated SUNY Adirondack student within one year of graduation.

It is understood that WSWHE BOCES will adhere to the following:

1. The Machine Tool Technology Instructor or guidance department at WSWHE BOCES will provide the chairperson of the Technology Department at SUNY Adirondack with a list of students that qualify for credit by July 15th of each academic school year.
2. The Machine Tool Technology Instructor or guidance department at WSWHE BOCES will keep the chairperson at SUNY Adirondack informed of any curriculum changes in the program.
3. The curriculum will be reviewed by WSWHE BOCES and SUNY Adirondack as needed.
4. This articulation agreement will be valid for two years from the date the agreement is signed.
