

SUBJECT: QUORUM AND ATTENDANCE AT BOARD MEETINGS

The quorum for any meeting of the Board shall be eight (8) members. No formal action shall be taken at any meeting at which a quorum is not present. When only a quorum exists, the Board shall act by unanimous vote unless otherwise required by the laws of the State of New York.

The District Superintendent and members of his/her staff at the District Superintendent's discretion shall attend all meetings of the Board. The District Superintendent shall attend all executive session meetings of the Board except those which concern his/her evaluation and salary determination. The Board may request the attendance of such additional persons as it desires. It is the duty of each member of the Board to attend all meetings of the Board.
