

SUBJECT: SPECIAL MEETINGS

Special meetings of the Board shall be held on call by any member of the Board. A reasonable and good faith effort shall be made by the District Superintendent or the Board President, as the case may be, to give every member of the Board a twenty-four hour notice of the time, place and purpose of the meeting.

In an emergency, if all Board members are present, the twenty-four hour notice requirement may be waived by unanimous agreement. In this situation, the Clerk of the Board may request each member to sign a waiver of notice and the fact of such signing shall be entered in the minutes.

Special meetings shall be open to the public in the same manner as are regular meetings. Public notice of the time and place of special meetings shall be given, to the extent practicable, to the news media and shall be conspicuously posted in the BOCES administrative office at a reasonable time prior thereto.
