

SUBJECT: DUTIES OF THE SCHOOL PHYSICIAN

The school physician/nurse practitioner shall be appointed by the Board of Education. The duties of the school physician/nurse practitioner shall include, but are not limited to, the following:

- a) Performs professional medical services in the examination and care of BOCES students, including physicals as needed. It is understood by both parties that the student physicals are the responsibility of the students' home school district;
- b) Develop the program of health services in cooperation with the District Superintendent;
- c) May conduct annual physicals for school bus drivers and occasional faculty drivers;
- d) Attend CSE/CPSE meetings when deemed necessary by the Director of Instructional Programs;
- e) Conduct a medical evaluation on any employee at the request of the Board of Education;
- f) Consult with BOCES and school nurses on health related matters;
- g) Approve on an annual basis the standing orders and list of first aid instructions;
- h) Conduct school building health inspections when requested;
- i) Assist BOCES during emergency/crisis situations;
- j) Serve as an advisor to the Administrative Cabinet; and
- k) Serve as a resource in addressing other health related issues.
